Subject: Abolition of affidavits and promotion of self- certification - reg.

To establish his/ her BPL status for eligibility under Aajeevika Skills, standard form SF5.1G1 in the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) at present provides that a prospective candidate shall be required to produce any of the following documents:

- Copy of BPL card
- Copy of BPL certificate
- Copy of DRDA BPL 2002 list
- Supplementary BPL List 2006
- Supplementary BPL List 2008
- Supplementary BPL List 2010
- Supplementary BPL List 2012
- Verification of BPL no. by Block Development Officer
- Verification of BPL no. by Gram Sachiv
- Verification of BPL no. by other Authority Officer
- PIP
- MGNREGA Job Card

2. However, in order to simplify the process and to enable candidates to furnish self-certified documents, it is stated that the following shall not be necessary:

- Verification of BPL no. by Block Development Officer
- Verification of BPL no. by Gram Sachiv
- Verification of BPL no. by other Authority Officer

3. It is stated that one of the other documentary evidences as mentioned in the standard form SF5.1G1, self-certified by the candidate, shall still be required.

4. This order comes into effect from the date of issue.
