Sub: Enrolment of DDU-GKY candidates in RSETI program -reg

Section 3.2.2.1 of the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) Guidelines provides for Mobilization, Counseling and Selection of candidates for skill training courses under DDU-GKY. Clause 6.2.1 of Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) provides for screening and selection of candidates for DDU-GKY courses based on aptitude test score. Clause 6.2.2 of SOP further lays down the procedures for counseling in terms of SF 6.2A2, which requires a PIA to explain to each candidate growth/ career prospects in each profession being offered in the training course and help the candidate choose a trade suitable to the aptitude. Yet, despite adherence to the Guidelines and processes in SOP, the program recognizes the fact that there is a likelihood of certain trained candidates not being able to obtain job after completion of training course under DDU-GKY program. In order to ensure that such candidates also get a sustainable livelihood, a suggestion has been received in the Ministry that such candidates should be allowed to access RSETI program for self-employment.

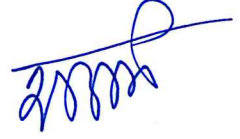
2. Taking note of the concern mentioned above, the Ministry hereby notifies the following instructions in order to enable candidates who have not got placement after training in DDU-GKY courses to obtain opportunities for self-employment through the RSETI program of the Ministry:

(a) A Project Implementing Agency (PIA) undertaking skill training courses under DDU-GKY shall maintain a list of candidates (batch-wise), who could not be given job-placement till the completion of project.

(b) PIA shall share the batch-wise list of unemployed candidates with the nearest RSETI center(s) in writing with a copy marked to Director, RSETI, Rural Livelihood Division, Department of Rural Development, Ministry of Rural Development, Samrat Hotel, New Delhi (edjanardhan@gmail.com or mcnarbg@gmail.com). PIA may obtain list of approved and operational RSETIs from the CEO, SRLM of the concerned State in which the PIA is undertaking DDU-GKY project.

(c) PIA shall ensure that the Project Closure Report (PCR) furnished to the CTSA/SRLM shall contain a statement from the PIA giving details of batch-wise list of candidates which has been shared with the RSETI(s).

3. This order comes into force with from the date of issue.



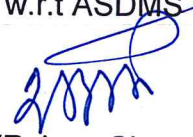
