Subject:- Coverage of Skills Development courses under DDU – GKY in Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY) / Gram Panchayats / Villages – reg.

Section 3.2.2.1.1 of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU – GKY) Guideline provide that mobilization of candidates by project Implementing Agency (PIA) for skill development courses under DDU – GKY project shall be undertaken in areas identified by State Rural Livelihoods Mission (SRLMs) concerned. Clause 6.1 of the Standard Operating Protocols (SOP) for DDU – GKY lays down the protocol for mobilization of candidates for Placement Linked Skills Development courses. As per the SOP, a PIA is required to seek a list of Gram Panchayats from SRLMs for mobilizing candidates in order to follow Gram panchayat saturation model.

2. Now, in terms of the decision of the Government for implementation of Pradhan Mantri Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAGY), priority in implementation of all development project has to be given to Gram Panchayats / villages identified under PMAGY. Accordingly, it is hereby stated that notwithstanding the provisions of DDU – GKY Guidelines and SOP for DDU- GKY projects, all SRLMs implementing DDU – GKY / Roshni project shall give priority in mobilization of candidates from Gram Panchayats / villages identified under PMAGY in the districts allotted in the sanctioned projects. In order to prioritize such identified Gram Panchayats / villages, the SRLMs may refer to the latest list of Gram Panchayats/ villages available at <http://iay.nic.in/mobile/reports/Dreports/SummarReportchosenGP.aspx>. All SRLMs shall categorize the identified PMAGY Gram Panchayats/villages in the districts allotted to PIAs under the sanctioned DDU – GKY/Roshni project for prioritization, candidate mobilization plan in such Gram Panchayats/villages in SF 6.1A given in SOP. A PIA may proceed to other non – PMAGY Gram Panchayats/villages only after completing mobilization exercise in PMAGY Gram Panchayats/villages in the districts allotted to them in sanctioned projects.

3. The SRLMS shall facilitate such prioritization and mobilization. Further, SRLMs monitoring projects under DDU – GKY / Roshni are requested to ensure that all the PIAs implementing DDU-GKY/Roshni projects comply with this notification. The compliance of the notification shall be reviewed on a quarterly basis by the SRLMs for both YP and AAP States.

4. This order comes into force with immediate effect.
